Addressing Biases



What is implicit bias? Do you have implicit bias? Guess what ... we all do! Our experiences shape who we are, and our dimensions of diversity—race, ethnicity, gender, height, weight, sexual orientation, place of birth, and other factors—impact the lens through which we view the world. In this training, hiring managers and supervisors confront the biases that can impact an equitable experience for students, and grapple with how to design inclusive processes.

- Become equipped to fairly conduct interview with youth that don't favor student students from privileged backgrounds
- Understand how a person of color can experience bias through microaggressions and how that impacts them over long periods of time
