

Education: Paraprofessional Competencies

Required Competencies

Aligned Instruction

Provides instruction that is aligned with the Colorado Academic Standards and their district's organized plan of instruction.

Knowledge of Disciplines Being Taught

Demonstrates knowledge of the content, central concepts, inquiry, appropriate evidence-based instructional practices, and specialized characteristics of the disciplines being taught.

Learning Environment

Fosters a predictable learning environment characterized by acceptable student behavior and efficient use of time in which each student has a positive, nurturing relationship with caring adults and peers.

Diversity and Community Engagement

Demonstrates an awareness of, a commitment to, and a respect for multiple aspects of diversity, while working toward common goals as a community of learners.

Individualization

Engages students as individuals including those with diverse needs and interests, across a range of ability levels by adapting their teaching for the benefit of students.

Family Collaboration

Works collaboratively with the families and/or significant adults for the benefit of students.

Communication

Models and promotes effective communication.

Professionalism

Demonstrates high standards for professional conduct.

Foundational Competencies

Clerical Tasks

Independently completes all clerical tasks on-time and proactively takes step to prepare for classes.

Supervision Responsibilities

Consistently maintains high expectations for behavior aligned with school systems and positively fosters engagement with students in a proactive manner.

Attitude/Disposition

Consistently displays a positive attitude towards challenging situations and actively seeks out feedback to improve overall performance.

Safety and Security

Follows proper safety protocols to ensure a safe environment for all students and/or staff.
